

## **ASA UMPIRE MEDALS PROGRAM**



### **BLUE**

**Must have been an active ASA registered umpire for at least three years and is currently an active registered umpire.**

**Must be in good standing with the local association and local association commissioner.**

### **BRONZE**

**1) Must have been an active ASA registered umpire for at least five years.**

**2) Applicant must complete either (a) or (b) below.**

**a. Must have umpired, or served as an Umpire in Chief, assistant UIC, or umpire coordinator in at least one local association championship or higher.**

**b. Or umpired at the local level for five years.**

**The Umpire must be in good standing with the local association and local association commissioner.**



## **SILVER**

**Must have been an active ASA registered umpire for seven years.**

**3) Applicant must complete either (a) or (b) below.**

**a. Must have umpired, or served as an Umpire in Chief, assistant UIC, or umpire coordinator in at least three national championships.**

**b. Or umpired at the local level for fifteen years.**

**3. National Umpire School can be used in place of one national championship.**

**4. Must be in good standing with the local association and local association commissioner.**



## **GOLD**

1. Must have been an active ASA registered umpire for seven years.
- 4) Applicant must complete either (a) or (b) below.
  - a. Must have umpired in at least three national championships, two of which must have been in the tournaments listed below:  
The evaluations in these two must be of the highest rating.  

<b>Fast Pitch:</b>	Men's or Women's "Major" Men's or Women's "Class A" Men's "Masters" 40 – Over Girl's "18 – Under Gold
<b>Slow Pitch:</b>	Men's "Major" and "Class A" Women's "Open" Men's Industrial "Major and "Class A" Men's "Major" 16-inch Armed Forces
<b>Modified Pitch:</b>	Men's "9-Man" Men's "10-Man" Women's
  - b. Or umpired at the local level for twenty years.
3. National Umpire School can be used in place of one national championship.
4. Must be in good standing with the local association and local association commissioner.
