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## M.A.A. DOUBLEHEADER LEAGUE RULES

# **NO CONCESSION DUTY!!**

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The current ASA Junior Olympic rules shall govern this league with the following modifications:

1. The umpires' decision will be final.
2. The home team is listed second on the league schedule.
3. Time limit will be 1 hour 20 minutes (DROP Dead at 1 hour 30 minutes ~ to break a tied score).  
If the game is not finished, or is tied at 1 hour 30 minutes, then the official game reverts back to the last legal complete inning.
4. International Tie Breaker Rule will be put into effect if the game is tied at 1 hour 20 minutes.
5. Starting/game time is forfeit time provided the previous game ended on time.
6. Free substitution for all offensive and defensive positions.
7. Courtesy runners are any time for the catcher, pitcher or injured player(s) only. However, in the interest of time, a courtesy runner shall run for the catcher on base with two outs. The courtesy runner will be the player who was the last out.
8. Bat the entire roster. Managers will exchange line up cards with the other manager, but not the umpire.
9. Team can begin or finish the game with less than nine players (no out penalty).
10. No inning will begin with less than 5 minutes remaining. The final score will be that at the end of the last full inning played. Innings still in progress with 5 minutes remaining will be completed.
11. Each team will provide team insurance meeting the minimum ASA requirements.
12. Teams will provide one new and two used yellow ASA approved balls for each game.
13. No refunds for games forfeited.
14. If rainout games cannot be re-scheduled, the refund will be \$24.00 per game per team.
15. Each team will provide their own uniforms and equipment meeting current ASA rules.
16. Alcohol or tobacco use is prohibited during the game by participants (i.e. coaches, players, anyone else inside the dugouts or on the field). No alcohol is allowed inside or on any part of the dugouts.
17. Only alcohol purchased from the Manchester Athletic Association is allowed within the MAA property. Manager/coaches are responsible for enforcing this rule among their fans and coaches. Any violations may result in forfeiture of the offending team's fans and/or team members. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**

*\* Team winning the league must play in the ASA Championship they qualify for in order to receive entry fee of up to \$450.00.  
Amounts based on Nine (9) Teams registering for league. Adjustments made in the event there are fewer teams.*
